AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LABELLING OF MILK PRODUCTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13B of chapter 94 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in line four, the word “may” and inserting in place
4 thereof the following word: — shall.

1 SECTION 2. Section 13B of Chapter 94 is further amended by
2 striking out, in lines six and seven, the words “provided that all
3 the milk contained in such package so labelled was produced
4 exclusively in one state” and inserting in place thereof the
5 following words: — provided further that if the milk contained
6 in such package has been produced in more than one state, the
7 label shall indicate the states where the milk was produced and
8 the percentage of milk contained therein attributable to each state.
