AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING STATE POLICE PROMOTIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 22C of the Massachusetts General Laws,  
2 as amended by C. 412 of the Acts of 1991, is hereby amended in  
3 Section 26 in the eighth paragraph by striking the words, "Any  
4 member who is a veteran shall have two points added to his  
5 examination score for the purpose of compiling an eligible list for  
6 promotion.", and inserting the words "Each candidate for  
7 promotion to any such grade who is a veteran shall have two  
8 points added to his general average mark."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
