## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

### AN ACT CLARIFYING USE OF INSURANCE PAYMENTS BY MUNICIPALITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The second sentence of Section 53 of Chapter 44 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out clause (2) and inserting in
- 3 place the following clause: —
- 4 “(2) sums not in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars recov-
- 5 ered under the terms of fire or physical damage insurance policy
- 6 and sums not in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars received in
- 7 restitution for damage done to such city, town or district property
- 8 may be used by the officer or department having control of the
- 9 city, town or district property for the restoration or replacement of
- 10 such property without specific appropriation and”.
