By Mr. Craven of Boston, petition of James J. Craven, Jr., relative to clothing allowances in the aid to families with dependent children program. Human Services and Elderly Affairs.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE A CLOTHING ALLOWANCE TO NEEDY CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding limitations on the payment
2 level, a non-recurring clothing allowance in the amount of one
3 hundred dollars shall be provided to each child eligible for Aid To
4 Families With Dependent Children on September first, nineteen
5 hundred and eighty-four; provided that such clothing allowance is
6 federally reimbursable; and provided further, that such clothing
7 allowance shall not be counted as income for determination of
8 eligibility or amount of benefits under the food stamp program;
9 and provided further that such clothing allowance shall be
10 included in the standard of need for the month of September,
11 nineteen hundred and eighty-four.

1 SECTION 2. A non-recurring clothing allowance in the
2 amount of one hundred dollars shall be provided to each child
3 eligible for General Relief on September first, nineteen hundred
4 and eighty-four; provided that such clothing allowance shall not
5 be counted as income for determination of eligibility or amount of
6 benefits under the food stamp program; and provided further that
7 such clothing allowance shall be included in the standard of need
for the month of September, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
