## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO GROUP INSURANCE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 11 of Chapter 32B is hereby amended by deleting the  
2 following sentence: — “The amount of group life insurance on each  
3 employee shall be \$2,000 and the amount of group accidental death  
4 and dismemberment insurance on each employee shall be \$2,000.”  
5 and replace it with the following: — “The amount of group life  
6 insurance on each employee shall be \$10,000 and the amount of  
7 group accidental death and dismemberment insurance on each  
8 employee shall be \$10,000.”
