AN ACT RELATIVE TO NUISANCE CONDITIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE  
SPREADING OF MANURE ON AGRICULTURAL LAND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 125A of Chapter 111 of the Massachusetts General Laws
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the last sentence in paragraph
- 3 one the following sentence: —
- 4 And further providing that said manure be plowed into the
- 5 ground within twenty-four hours.
