AN ACT PROVIDING ACCESS TO WATER BODIES UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following new section: —
- 3 *Section 103.* Cities and towns shall have limited access to the
- 4 Metropolitan District commission reservoirs provided they adopt
- 5 certain restrictions, water zoning or otherwise, to ensure that said
- 6 reservoirs are not unduly contaminated by oil.
