AN ACT AUTHORIZING A SUPERVISOR HEARING OFFICER FOR THE NANTUCKET BRANCH OF THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any General or Special law to
2 the contrary the Registrar of Motor Vehicles is hereby authorized
3 and directed to establish the position of Supervisor Hearing
4 Officer at the Nantucket, Massachusetts Branch of Registry of
5 Motor Vehicles.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
