The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SIZE OF RETIREMENT BOARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause 4b of section 20 of chapter 32 as hereby
2 amended by striking: — “and a third member who shall be chosen
3 by the other two members of the board for a term of three years. If
4 the third member is not chosen by the other two members within
5 thirty days after the expiration of the term of the third member,
6 said member shall be appointed in a city by the mayor, subject to
7 confirmation by the city council, or in a town by the board of
8 selectmen.” and inserting in place thereof the following: — “and a
9 third, fourth and a fifth member who shall be chosen by the other
10 two members of the board from outside the membership of the
11 retirement system for a term of three years. If the third, fourth, or
12 fifth member is not chosen by the other two members of the board
13 within thirty days after the expiration of the third, fourth or fifth
14 member’s term, said member shall be appointed in a city by the
15 mayor, subject to confirmation by the city council, or in a town by
16 the board of selectmen.”

1 SECTION 2. Clause 4b of section 20 of chapter 32 is hereby
2 amended by striking the clause “the term of the second member
3 shall be so arranged as not to expire in the year of expiration of the
4 term of the third member” and inserting in place thereof the
5 following clause: — the terms of the members shall be so arranged
6 such that no more than two members’ terms expire in any one
7 calendar year.
