AN ACT REQUIRING THE IDENTIFICATION OF LEGISLATIVE AGENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 41 of Chapter 3 as most recently amended by Chapter 68
- 2 of the Acts of 1981 is hereby amended by striking out the fifth
- 3 paragraph and inserting in place the following: —
- 4 Upon receipt of said notification required in section forty from
- 5 the employer of a legislative agent, the secretary shall issue to each
- 6 legislative agent a non-transferable identificaiton card which shall
- 7 include but not be limited to a photograph, the address and name
- 8 of employer or employees of said legislative agent, and shall have
- 9 printed thereon the words "Registered Agent." Any such person,
- 10 while in state office buildings, shall have said identification dis-
- 11 played prominently on his person.
