### AN ACT RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR CONVICTIONS UNDER THE DRUNK DRIVING STATUTE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 24D of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 6 of chapter 373 of the acts of 1982, is hereby
- 3 further amended by striking out the last paragraph and inserting in
- 4 place thereof the following paragraph: —
- 5 when imposing sentence pursuant to subparagraph (1) of para-
- 6 graph (a) of section twenty-four or this section, the court shall
- 7 require the defendant to serve a minimum of thirty hours in public
- 8 service or in a community work project as a condition of
- 9 probation.
