By Mr. Galvin of Boston, petition of William F. Galvin that the Department of Public Utilities be prohibited from approving rate increases for local telephone calls from coin-operated telephones. Government Regulations.

AN ACT FREEZING THE BASIC RATE FOR LOCAL TELEPHONE CALLS FROM A PAY PHONE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 159 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 19 the following section:—

3 *Section 19A.* The department shall not approve any schedule
4 filed by a common carrier pursuant to section nineteen, if said
5 schedule increases in any manner the rate charged for a local call
6 made on a coin-operated telephone that is in effect on January
7 first, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.
