AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NUMBER OF ASSISTANT CLERKS IN THE DISTRICT COURT DIVISION OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 478 of the Acts of 1978, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — An assistant clerk with salaries
5 payable by the Commonwealth shall be appointed in all district
6 courts of the Commonwealth.
