AN ACT MODIFYING THE UNEMPLOYMENT PENSION OFFSET LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-nine of chapter one hundred fifty-one A of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in the first
3 paragraph of subsection (6) thereof, the last proviso and inserting
4 in place thereof the following: —

5 . . . and provided further that if the individual contributed less
6 than fifty percent of the contributions to such pension, retirement
7 or retired pay, annuity or other payment plan, the amount of
8 benefits otherwise payable to such individual shall be reduced by
9 fifty percent of the amount of such pension, retirement or retired
10 pay, annuity or other payment plan, but if the individual contrib-
11 uted fifty percent or more of the contributions to such pension,
12 retirement or retired pay, annuity or other payment plan, the
13 amount of benefits otherwise payable to such individual shall not
14 be reduced.
