**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT REGULATING THE STATE LOTTERY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 10 of the General Laws is hereby amend-  
2 ed by striking out section 25, as inserted by section 2 of chapter 813  
3 of the acts of 1971, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 section: —

5 The apportionment of the total revenues accruing from the sale  
6 of lottery tickets or shares and from all other sources shall be as  
7 follows: — (a) the payment of prizes to the holders of winning  
8 tickets or shares which in any case shall be no less than forty-five  
9 percent of the total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery  
10 tickets; (b) the payment of costs incurred in the operation and  
11 administration of the lottery, including the expenses of the com-  
12 mission and the costs resulting from any contract or contracts  
13 entered into from promotional, advertising or operational services  
14 or for the purchase or lease of lottery equipment and materials  
15 which in no case shall exceed eleven percent of the total revenues  
16 accruing from the sale of lottery tickets, subject to appropriation;  
17 (c) the balance to be used for the purposes set forth in clause (c) of  
18 section thirty-five.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall be effective for the fiscal year be-  
2 ginning July 1, 1985.
