AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT FOR THE USE OF THE COMMONWEALTH'S RECREATIONAL AREAS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two D of chapter one hundred thirty-two  
2 A of the General Laws is amended by adding to subdivision (2) the  
3 following sentence: — Massachusetts residents over the age of  
4 sixty-two shall be allowed such use at the rate of fifty percent of  
5 such charges and fees.

1 SECTION 2. Section seven of chapter one hundred thirty-two  
2 A of the General Laws is amended by adding the following sen-  
3 tence to the first paragraph: — Massachusetts residents over the  
4 age of sixty-two shall be charged at the rate of fifty percent of any  
5 fee or charge provided for in this section.

1 SECTION 3. Section forty-one of chapter ninety-two of the  
2 General Laws is amended by adding the following sentence: —  
3 Massachusetts residents over the age of sixty-two shall be charged  
4 at the rate of fifty percent of any charge established under this  
5 section.
