In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION SHALL BE CLASSIFIED IN GROUP 4 OF THE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32, Section 3, paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended to include within the definition of
3 Group 4 employees of the Alcoholic Beverages Control Com-
4 mission who hold the position of Alcoholic Beverages Investigator,
5 Chief Alcoholic Beverages Investigator or Supervising Alcoholic
6 Beverages Investigator, employees of the Division of Marine and
7 Recreational Vehicles of the Department of Fisheries and Wildlife
8 who hold the position of Enforcement Agent or Special Officer,
9 employees of the Bureau of Special Investigations of the Executive
10 Office of Administration and Finance who hold the position of
11 Auditor and Fraudulent Claims Special Investigator, Chief Fraudu-
12 lent Claims Investigator, Fraudulent Claims Investigator, Fraudu-
13 lent Claims Accountant/Auditor, Fraudulent Claims Special
14 Investigator, Senior Fraudulent Claims Welfare Auditor or Super-
15 visor of Welfare Audits, employees of the Division of Commercial
16 Motor Vehicles Investigation of the Department of Public Utilities
17 who hold the position of Commercial Motor Vehicle Investigator
18 or Supervising Investigator of Commercial Motor Vehicles, and
19 employees of the Parole Board who hold the position of Parole
20 Officer and Parole Supervisor.
