## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE COLLECTIVE PURCHASING STATUTES SO AS TO PERMIT STATE AGENCIES TO JOIN IN COLLECTIVE PURCHASING EFFORTS OF CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:*

1 Section 22B of chapter 7 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting at the end thereof the following sentence:— Any  
3 public agency of the commonwealth may purchase materials, sup-  
4 plies, equipment, or services with respect to which competitive bids  
5 were submitted to two or more political subdivisions under this  
6 section subject to authorization of the state purchasing agent and  
7 such rules, regulations and procedures as may be established from  
8 time to time by the state purchasing agent.
