### AN ACT REQUIRING ALCOHOL EDUCATION IN DRIVER EDUCATION SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 32G of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by Chapter 680 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby further  
3 amended by adding the following new paragraph: —

4 Any person licensed to give instruction in the operation of motor  
5 vehicles shall include in that instruction at least five hours of  
6 classroom education related to the impact the use of alcohol has  
7 on an operator of a motor vehicle. Such instruction shall comply  
8 with a curriculum to be developed by the Division of Alcoholism,  
9 the Department of Education and the Registry of Motor Vehicles.
