AN ACT RELATIVE TO HANDICAPPED PARKING PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by adding after Section 2 the following new section: —

3 “Section 2A. The Registrar shall furnish at his office a permit
4 designating that the applicant has suffered the loss, or permanent
5 loss, of one or both feet, or one or both hands, or any other
6 standards of disability and handicap, and of qualification for the
7 issuance of said permit as he deems proper. Said permit may only
8 be displayed in a pleasure passenger vehicle when said vehicle is
9 being used for the transportation of the individual to whom the
10 permit has been issued.”

1 SECTION 2. Section 22 of Chapter 40, as most recently
2 amended by Section 73A of Chapter 329 of the Acts of 1980, is
3 hereby amended by striking the second paragraph and inserting in
4 its place the following new paragraph: —

5 “No penalty shall be imposed upon any disabled veteran, or
6 handicapped person, whose vehicle bears the distinctive number
7 plate authorized by section two chapter ninety, or the permit
8 authorized by Section 2A Chapter Ninety, for parking such vehicle
9 on any way for a longer period of time than permitted by said
10 ordinances, by-laws, rules or orders.”
