### AN ACT PROHIBITING BANKS FROM IMPOSING CHARGES ON CERTAIN SAVINGS ACCOUNTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 10 of chapter 1670 of the General Laws, added by
- 2 section 9 of chapter 155 of the acts of 1982, is hereby amended by
- 3 adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 No bank or federally chartered bank shall impose a mainte-
- 5 nance or service charge on a negotiable withdrawal order account
- 6 if such account has averaged a minimum of five hundred dollars on
- 7 deposit during the statement period.
