AN ACT REQUIRING RETAIL SELLERS OF HOME ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS TO MAINTAIN ON-PREMISES REPAIR FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 the following section: —

3 *Section 77.* Every seller of electronic equipment of products
4 designed to be used in a personal residence for personal, family, or
5 household purposes shall maintain on the premises where soda
6 equipment or products are sold facilities for their maintenance and
7 repair. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall
8 be punished by a fine of one hundred dollars.
