AN ACT TO PERMIT LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF ORLEANS, TO GRANT ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven-
2 teen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws,
3 the board of selectmen of the town of Orleans, acting as the
4 licensing authority of said town, is hereby authorized and directed
5 to grant licenses under section fifteen of said chapter one hundred
6 and thirty-eight for the annual sale of all alcoholic beverages not
7 to be drunk on premises to all existing seasonal all alcoholic not to
8 be drunk on premises license holders, which licenses shall be
9 subject to the provision of said chapter one hundred and thirty-
10 eight, except as provided in said section seventeen. No seasonal all
11 alcoholic beverage not to be drunk on premises license shall be
12 issued by said authority until its estimate of any temporary
13 increased resident population, as provided in said section seven-
14 teen, exceeds that number which would otherwise permit the
15 issuance by said authority under the provisions of said chapter one
16 hundred and thirty-eight for those additional units of temporary
17 increased resident population.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
