AN ACT REQUIRING CONTINUED PAY FOR STATE EMPLOYEES SERVING WITH MILITARY FORCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, any employee of the commonwealth, whether full-
3 time, part time, seasonal, temporary or provisional shall be com-
4 pensated at his usual rate of pay for all time lost from work while
5 serving on duty with the military reserves of the United States or
6 the National Guard.
