## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

### AN ACT PLACING REGISTERS OF PROBATE AND SUPERIOR COURT CLERKS UNDER THE JUDICIAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 65G the following section: —

3 *Section 65H.* Registers of the probate and family court depart-  
4 ment of the trial court and clerks of the superior court department  
5 of the trial court shall upon retirement be entitled to receive a  
6 pension or retirement allowance for life at an annual rate equal to  
7 three-fourths of his average yearly earnings as a register of probate  
8 or clerk, as the case may be.

9 Pensions under this section shall be paid from the same source  
10 and in the same manner as the salaries of the justices of the court  
11 from which the register or clerk was retired.
