The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE IMPOSITION OF CHARGES UPON CONSUMERS FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
- 2 the contrary, the department of public utilities is hereby prohibited
- 3 from approving any charges to consumers of electricity attributed
- 4 to increased costs of construction of nuclear power plants located
- 5 in the town of Plymouth and in the municipality of Seabrook in
- 6 the state of New Hampshire.
