AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSES TO OPERATE MOTOR VEHICLES OF PERSONS SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23A of chapter 708 of the acts of 1941, as amended by
2 chapter 507 of the acts of 1955, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph: —

5 Upon the expiration of a license to operate a motor vehicle of
6 any person serving in the armed forces of the United States, he
7 shall, upon presentation of proof of such service, be issued a new
8 license without paying a fee.
