## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT FIRE PREVENTION APPARATUS BE PRESENT AT THE SCENE OF MEDICAL EVACUATIONS PERFORMED BY HELICOPTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, there  
2 shall be present, during the arrival and departure of any helicopter  
3 used for the evacuation of injured persons to hospital facilities, fire  
4 prevention apparatus sufficient to respond to any fire emergency  
5 that might occur during such period of evacuation. The commis-  
6 sioner of the department of public safety is hereby authorized and  
7 directed to promulgate rules and regulations which direct that  
8 local fire departments provide such fire prevention apparatus to  
9 the scenes of such medical evacuations.
