AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF TREASURER-COLLECTOR OF TAXES
IN THE TOWN OF HOPEDALE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The officer of treasurer-collector of taxes of the
2 town of Hopedale is hereby established. Said treasurer-collector of
3 taxes shall be appointed by the Board of selectmen of said town for
4 a term not to exceed three years and shall perform all duties
5 hereinbefore performed by the treasurer and tax collector of said
6 town and shall have such other powers and duties as may from
7 time to time be established. Said town may establish by by-law
8 such qualifications for such office as deemed necessary and
9 appropriate. Any vacancy in the office may be filled in like manner
10 for the unexpired portion of the office.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be effective immediately upon its
2 passage.
