AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DIVISION OF MARINE FISHERIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The director of the division of marine fisheries is
2 hereby authorized and directed to promulgate rules and regula-
3 tions regarding the licensing of recreational and commercial lob-
4 ster divers.

1 SECTION 2. *Resolved*, That the director of the division of
2 marine fisheries is hereby authorized and directed to make an
3 investigation and study relative to the feasibility of establishing a
4 ten pot limit licensing system for recreational lobster divers, limit-
5 ing such divers to ten lobsters for their own consumption, and
6 making it illegal for a dealer to buy lobster from someone other
7 than a licensed commercial fisherman.
