AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CIVIL SERVICE APPOINTMENT FOR CERTAIN PROVISIONAL AND CERTIFIED TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any employee,
2 regardless of whether or not he/she was serving in a provisional or
3 certified temporary capacity on January 4, 1982, who served as a
4 provisional or certified temporary employee six months prior to
5 June 1, 1981 shall be entitled to the rights granted in said section 26
6 of chapter 767 of the Acts of 1981.
