AN ACT RELATING TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR COMMUNITIES OUTSIDE THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FACING INCREASED SEWER CHARGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, there is hereby established a Local Aid Fund, subject  
3 to appropriation, the purpose of which is to furnish financial aid to  
4 cities and towns which do not fall within the jurisdiction of the
