In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT PROHIBITING MOVIES THEATERS AND PLAYHOUSES FROM BARRING PATRONS WHO BRING IN CERTAIN FOOD PRODUCTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 181B the following section: —

3 *Section 181C.* No person licensed to exhibit a show motion
4 picture films as live plays to the general public shall prohibit or bar
5 any paying patron from bringing into any theatre or playhouse
6 food products but not including any beverages. Whoever violates
7 the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more
8 than one hundred dollars.
