### AN ACT RELATING TO TINTED GLASS ON MOTOR VEHICLES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7 of Chapter 90, as amended, is hereby further amended
- 2 by inserting after the first paragraph, the following sentence: —
- 3 “No person shall sell, offer for sale or install on any motor
- 4 vehicle manufactured for the 1986 model year and thereafter any
- 5 windshield or windows which are tinted to such an extent that
- 6 visibility is seriously impaired, according to standards adopted by
- 7 the Registrar.”
