AN ACT ALLOWING A LOCAL HOTEL/MOTEL EXCISE TAX IN THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary the town of
- 2 Plymouth shall be allowed to levy an excise tax of 4.3% upon the
- 3 transfer of occupancy of any room or rooms in a hotel, lodging
- 4 house, or motel located within the town.
