By Mr. Corazzini of Shrewsbury, petition of Leo R. Corazzini (by vote of the town) that the town of Northborough be authorized to appropriate a certain sum of money for a study of the silting of a portion of the Assabet River. Natural Resources and Agriculture. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NORTHBOROUGH TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR A STUDY OF THE SILTING OF A PORTION OF THE ASSABET RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The town of Northborough is hereby authorized to appropriate
- 2 a sum of money not to exceed fifty thousand dollars to the water
- 3 resources commission to study the causes of and a remedy for, the
- 4 present silting of the Assabet River at Northborough south of the
- 5 Allen Street Bridge.

3 *Section 3B.* At every sentencing proceeding in a district or su-
 4 perior court, the court shall receive from the probation department
 5 prior to sentencing a statement assessing the impact of the defend-
 6 ant's criminal behavior upon the victim, and may receive from the
 7 victim a written or oral statement concerning such impact.
