AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF AUBURN TO PAY A CERTAIN UNPAID BILL TO GRANGER LYNCH FOR SERVICES RENDERED NOTWITHSTANDING THE FAILURE OF THE TOWN TO COMPLY WITH THE LAW RELATIVE TO COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Auburn is hereby authorized to appropriate money
2 for the payment of, and, after such appropriation, the treasurer of
3 said town is authorized to pay to Granger Lynch the sum of
4 seventeen thousand three hundred dollars for the paving of an
5 asphalt parking lot at the Bryn Mawr school during fiscal year
6 nineteen hundred and eighty-three notwithstanding the failure of
7 said town to comply with the appropriate provisions of law rela-
8 tive to competitive bidding in the awarding of the contract.
