Jordan, Jr. (With the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to exempt all positions in the office of city clerk of the city of Springfield from civil Service law and rules. AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN POSITIONS FROM CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All positions in the Office of the City Clerk of the
2 City of Springfield shall be exempt from the provisions of Chapter
3 thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the
2 Civil Service Status of any person employed in the Office of the
3 City Clerk on the effective date of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
