## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN PROVISION OF INLAND FISHERIES AND GAME.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 92 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as added by  
2 Section 1 of Chapter 802 of the Acts of 1967, is hereby amended by  
3 striking said section and inserting in place thereof:

4 If any part, section or subdivision of this chapter, or the applica-  
5 tion thereof, shall be held by any court having equity jurisdiction to  
6 be invalid, unconstitutional or inoperative as to any particular  
7 person, persons or conditions, the remainder hereof, or the applica-  
8 tion of any such part, section or subdivision to other persons and  
9 conditions, shall not be affected thereby.
