AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE CAUCUS SYSTEM IN THE TOWN OF
RUSSELL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 498 of the acts of 1983 is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following
3 section: —

4 *Section 2.* The town of Russell is hereby authorized to conduct
5 town caucuses pursuant to the provisions of sections one hundred
6 and seventeen to one hundred and twenty, inclusive, of chapter
7 fifty-three of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The action taken at the town caucuses held on
2 March nineteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four, and the town
3 election held on May seventh, nineteen hundred and eighty-four,
4 are hereby validated, ratified and confirmed as if section one were
5 in effect at the same time caucuses were held.
