AN ACT REGARDING SALARY SCHEDULES OF CHIEF PROBATION OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Sections 99B and 99D of chapter 276 are hereby amended by
2 striking the sections in their entirety and inserting in their place the
3 following new section:

4 *Section 99D.* The salaries of chief probation officers or acting
5 chief probation officers shall be paid by the commonwealth in
6 accordance with the management classification and compensation
7 plan established by the chief administrative justice of the trial court
8 pursuant to section 9 of chapter 211B of the general laws.
