AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCOME TAX DEDUCTION FOR CERTAIN PAYMENTS MADE TO THE EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after subparagraph
3 (8) the following subparagraph: —

4 (9) Contributions made by a domestic service unit to the
5 employment compensation fund under the provisions of chapter
6 one hundred fifty-one A for domestic services performed in a
7 private household.
