AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ONE COURT OFFICER FOR THE BARNSTABLE COUNTY PROBATE COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 30 of chapter 217 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 section 155 of chapter 478 of the acts of 1978, is hereby amended by
- 3 inserting after the word "officers", in line 3, the following words: —
- 4 and the judge of probate for the county of Barnstable may appoint
- 5 one officer,.

For the purpose of amending section 10 of Chapter 1, Act No. 1789, approved July 1, 1910, to read as follows: "The Board of Education shall have the honor to certify to the Governor the names of the persons who have been elected to the office of member of the Board of Education for the term beginning on the first day of January next."
