AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF THE SEVEN AND ONE-HALF PER CENT SURTAX LEVIED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER SIXTY-TWO OF THE GENERAL LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section eighty-eight of Chapter six hundred and
2 eight-four of the Acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-five is
3 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect for taxable years ending
2 on or after December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
