AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEERING TO INSTITUTE A PILOT PROGRAM FOR WASTE MOTOR OIL RECOVERY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 21A of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 14 the following section: —

3 *Section 15.* The Department of Environmental Quality Engi-
4 neering is hereby directed to institute a pilot program to promote
5 the recovery and reuse of waste motor oil recovery in a selected
6 region of Massachusetts.

7 Such program shall attempt to prevent damage or threatened
8 damage to the public health, safety, welfare and the environment
9 caused by the dumping of motor oils into the ground or the water
10 system.

11 The pilot program shall include but not be limited to oil holding
12 tanks being placed in central locations to be used by the public for
13 the disposal of their used motor oil. The collected motor oil shall
14 then be sold to a refining company with the proceeds going to defray
15 the expenses of the program or distributed to the communities
16 involved in the program.
