AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REPORTING OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding in line 4 of the first paragraph, after the
3 word "property", the following words: — or in which the vehicle or
4 vehicles involved proceeded through a "right turn on red" intersec-
5 tion.

1 SECTION 2. Section 26 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
3 The registrar shall compile statistics on all "right turn on red"
4 accidents and submit an annual report to the General Court. Said
5 annual report shall be submitted no later than November 3 in any
6 calendar year.
