

By Mr. McNeil of Malden, petition of John C. McNeil, Michael J. McGlynn and Angelo R. Cataldo that the Metropolitan District Commission be directed to relocate and make certain improvements to a water main in the city of Malden. Housing and Urban Development.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO RELOCATE AND MAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO A 48-INCH WATER MAIN IN THE CITY OF MALDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Metropolitan District Commission, herein-
2 after called the Commission is hereby authorized and directed to
3 relocate and reconstruct a portion of 48-inch L.S. water main,
4 Sections 6 and 7, Metropolitan Waterworks Distribution System
5 between Station 460 & 50 (Sect. 6) and Station 463 & 50 (Sect. 7) in
6 Malden, Mass. and other projects and works as may be required.
7 The Commission may make application for federal assistance in
8 the construction of any project authorized by this act and any
9 federal funds to be received shall be credited to the Metropolitan
10 District Commission funds and be used to pay debt service costs
11 incurred as authorized by this act.

1 SECTION 2. The Commission, for the purposes of this act,
2 may, on behalf of the Commonwealth, take by eminent domain
3 under Chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws, or acquire by
4 purchase or otherwise any lands, waters, water rights, water-
5 courses, rights of way, easements, or other property or interest in
6 property, and shall have all the rights, powers and duties and be
7 subject to the limitations of Section thirty-two of Chapter ninety-
8 two of the General Laws; provided, however, that cities and towns
9 in the area or areas within which construction may occur shall

10 grant to the Commission the right to enter upon any public land
11 and to construct such facilities as may be necessary without re-
12 course to damages therefor. The Commission, however, shall, as
13 provided in said Section thirty-two, heed all reasonable requests of
14 officials of said cities and towns to restore such public property to
15 its present condition as far as practicable.

1 SECTION 3. To meet the expenditures necessary in carrying
2 out the provisions of this act, the state treasurer shall, upon request
3 of the Governor, issue and sell at public or private sale bonds of the
4 Commonwealth, registered or with interest coupons attached, as
5 he may deem best, to an amount to be specified by the Governor
6 from time to time but not exceeding, in the aggregate, the sum of
7 \$1,000,000. Such bonds shall be designated on the face, Metropoli-
8 tan Water District Loan, Act of 1985, and shall be on the serial
9 payment plan for such maximum term of years, not exceeding
10 twenty years, the Governor may recommend to the general court
11 pursuant to section three of Article LXII of the Amendments to the
12 Constitution of the Commonwealth, the maturities thereof to be so
13 arranged that the amounts payable in the several years of the
14 period of amortization other than the final year shall be as nearly
15 equal as in the opinion of the State Treasurer, it is practicable to
16 make them. Said bonds shall bear interest semi-annually at such
17 rate the State Treasurer, with the approval of the Governor, shall
18 fix. The initial maturities of such bonds shall be payable not later
19 than one year from the date of issue thereof and the entire issue not
20 later than June thirtieth, two thousand and six.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
