### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING FINES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 20A½ of Chapter 90 is hereby amended by striking
- 2 therefrom the fourth sentence of the eighth paragraph and inserting
- 3 in place thereof the following sentence: —
- 4 Upon such notification to the registrar, an additional twenty
- 5 dollar charge shall be assessed against the registered owner of said
- 6 vehicle. This additional charge shall be collected by the city or town
- 7 in which the violation occurred. Ten dollars of this charge shall be
- 8 payable to each, the registrar of motor vehicles and the city or town.
- 9 The portion payable to the registrar of motor vehicles shall be
- 10 turned over to the Commonwealth on a semi-annual basis.
