AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section fifteen of chapter sixteen is hereby amend-
2 ed by adding the following sentence: — In addition to the
3 members provided for above, there shall be five additional
4 members to be appointed by the governor no one of whom shall be
5 or have been a public school teacher within the commonwealth
6 and who shall serve at the pleasure of the governor but not longer
7 than the term of office of the appointing governor and who shall
8 serve only with respect to proceedings of the board under clause (2)
9 of section sixteen of chapter thirty-two.

1 SECTION 2. Clause (2) of section sixteen of chapter thirty-two
2 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: — For the
3 purpose of performing the duties hereunder of the teachers'
4 retirement board a quorum of the board shall be the chairman and
5 four other members of whom at least two shall be the members
6 appointed by the governor who are not and were not public school
7 teachers within the commonwealth, and a finding or decision of
8 the board that a removal or discharge is not justified shall require
9 the concurrence of the chairman and at least two other members
10 who are not and were not public school teachers with the
11 commonwealth.
