The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BETWEEN EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS AND THE DIRECTORS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to restore full collective bargaining
3 rights to M.B.T.A. employees, therefore it is hereby declared to be
4 an emergency law necessary for the immediate preservation of the
5 public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 19, clause (viii) of chapter 161A of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the present clause (viii) as appears
3 in Section 8 of chapter 581 of the Acts of 1980 and inserting in place
4 thereof the following: —

5 (viii) to hire part-time employees, provided however that the
6 hours, days of work, wages, benefits, seniority, holidays, vacations,
7 pensions of part-time employees and the number of part-time em-
8 ployees in any classification shall be subjects of collective bar-
9 gaining.
